

6 STEPS



What to do after a CAR ACCIDENT in Massachusetts

1



Check for Injuries

Make sure that you are not injured. Find out if anyone involved in the incident is hurt or harmed. If anyone requires medical assistance, call 911.

2



Call the Police

If there was significant damage to property, call the police. Provide exact details like where the crash occurred, how many vehicles were involved, and any other important facts.

3



Exchange Information

Exchange contact and insurance information with the other driver: full name and contact information; insurance company and policy number; driver's license and license plate number; type, color, and model of vehicle.

4



Do Not Admit Fault

Try to think calmly and clearly. Never admit that the accident was your fault, even if you think it was! Statements of liability can harm your case if it becomes a legal issue.

5



Document the Accident

Take pictures or videos of damaged cars or nearby property. If you're injured, document bruising, swelling, cuts, and areas of discomfort. A skilled attorney can use these pictures to raise the value of your case in court.

6
